Major Tourist Spots 觀光景點介紹

- A Hiroshima Castle 廣島城**
 In 1589, the feudal lord Terumoto Mori started to build the castle, known as the Carp castle. It was later the seats for the Fukushima and the Asano families. After its destruction in the atomic bomb blast, it was reconstructed in 1958 as it stands today. Now it's a museum, its inner rooms convey a realistic feeling of Hiroshima's history.
 廣島城於1589年由毛利輝元開始興建，之後成為福島氏與淺野氏的居城。天守閣雖然在原子彈爆炸後建築物被毀損，但於1958年重建，成為用來介紹以武家文化為主的歷史博物館，亦可參觀重建後的二之丸建築。

- B The A-Bomb Dome 原子彈爆炸遺址**
 The A-Bomb Dome was called the Hiroshima prefecture industrial Promotion Hall, before it was destroyed by the atomic bomb. The A-Bomb Dome was registered on the UNESCO World Heritage list in 1996.
 核爆前稱為「廣島縣產業獎勵館」，展示及收藏廣島特產，還受到原子彈轟炸後，逐漸就被稱為「原子彈爆炸遺址」，並以作為廢除核武和人類永久和平的象徵，於1996年列為世界文化遺產。
 ⑦ Free of charge ⑧ A short walk from the "A-Bomb Dome" bus stop, and an 8-minute walk from the "Peace Memorial Park" bus stop. ⑨ 原子彈爆炸遺址前，公車站下車即可看到。⑩ 和平公園前，公車站下車步行約8分鐘
- C Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum 廣島和平紀念資料館**
 Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum was established in August, 1955 to show the effects of the atomic bomb and to promote world peace. The museum uses artifacts from the bombing and historic records to describe the effects and aftermath of the atomic bomb.
 資料館於1955年8月開館，其目的在於向全世界傳達核戰所帶來的慘狀，與廢除核武和實現世界永久和平的心願。資料館除了展示核災資料外，同時也介紹廣島遭受原子彈爆炸前後的發展歷程和核武的發展現狀等。
 8:30~18:00 (Last admission 30 minutes prior to closing) and 8:30~17:00 from December to February. Opening hours are extended in August and the building is closed 12/30 and 12/31. 8:30~18:00 (最後於閉館前30分鐘入內) 8月8:30~19:00(8/5-8/6, 8/30~20:00)。12月8:30~17:00 12/30、12/31休館。

 ⑫ A 1-minute walk from the "Peace Memorial Park" bus stop, and an 8-minute walk from the "A-Bomb Dome" bus stop. ⑬ 和平公園前，公車站下車步行約1分鐘。⑭ 原子彈爆炸遺址前，公車站下車步行約8分鐘
- D Shukkeien Garden 縮景園**
 The Garden was created by Nagaakira Asano, the Daimyo of Hiroshima, for his villa in 1620. The present style of the garden is a product of an extensive renovation in 1783. 縮景園由廣島藩主淺野長親於1620年作為別墅的庭園而興建。1783年的「天明大改修」大改修，修築了與現狀相符的景緻，並在1940年指定為國家名勝。
 9:00~18:00 (Last admission 30 minutes prior to closing) and 9:00~17:00 from September to March. Closed 12/29 to 12/31. 9:00~18:00 (最後於閉館前30分鐘入內) 9月~3月9:00~17:00 12/29~12/31休館。
 ⑮ General admission:260yen. High school and University students:150yen. Elementary school students:100yen

- E Hiroshima Prefectural Art Museum 廣島縣立美術館**
 The museum houses more than 4,800 works of art. This collection has pieces relating to Hiroshima prefecture, Asia and the 1920s-30s. The works of art on display change four times a year.
 廣島縣立美術館收藏與廣島相關的藝術品，以及日本和亞洲的工藝品，以1920~30年代的藝術品為主。共收藏超過4,800件作品。每年大約會更換4次展出來介紹廣島藝術。
 9:00~17:00 (Last admission 30 minutes prior to closing) Periods of extended opening hours. Closed on Mondays (except for public holidays and substitute holidays) and during the New Year's holidays. 9:00~17:00 (最後於閉館前30分鐘入內)。開館時間有時會延長。逢周一及新年期間休館(例假日及補休假日，特別展期間除外)。

- F Hiroshima Museum of Art 廣島美術館**
 The museum's permanent exhibition has 90 works of modern art. These include paintings by Claude Monet, Pierre-Auguste Renoir, Vincent Van Gogh, as well as modern and traditional Japanese style paintings. The museum also holds special exhibitions 5-6 times a year.
 廣島美術館的常設展共有90件現代藝術品，包括克勞德·莫奈、皮耶-奧古斯特·雷諾瓦、文森·梵高，以及日本傳統和現代的繪畫。博物館也每年舉辦5-6次特別展。

- G Hiroshima City Museum of Contemporary Art 廣島市現代美術館**
 The museum was designed by the renowned architect Kisho Kurokawa and is situated in Hijiyama Park. In the museum grounds, there are works of modern art by artists such as Henry Moore. The museum houses a diverse collection of contemporary art from around the world.
