- 28 Nielson Park/*Kuloong*: parklands, beach and rock pools
- 29 Watsons Bay/*Kutti*: famous seafood restaurants and ex-fishing village
- 30 Camp Cove/*Mit-ta-la*: beach at start of South Head nature walk
- 3 South Head / Tar-ral-be: military relics and Hornby Lighthouse
- 32 Middle Head/Kuba Kaba: Whale Dreaming Ceremonial site
- 33 North Head/ Garungal: where in 1788 local Aborginals were met
- 34 Quarantine Station/Garungal: the most haunted site in Australia
- 35 Middle Harbour/ Warringà: the lighthouse marks the entrance to Middle Harbour
- 36 Manly/*Kayoo-may*: one of Australia's most famous beaches
