

- The 'Picturing the Cosmos' exhibition (18 July 2023 – June 2025) takes children on a journey through art's representation of space in different cultures.
- 'Letters of Light' (13 Sep 2023 – 14 Jan 2024) exhibits the Quran, the Christian Bible (Old and New Testaments) and the Hebrew Bible (Tanakh), exploring their context, practices, and role in intellectual and artistic history.
- 'Cartier, Islamic Inspiration and Modern Design' (15 Nov 2023 to 24 Mar 2024) highlights the influence of Islamic arts on Cartier's design from the beginning of the 20th century to the present day.
- 'Louvre Abu Dhabi Art Here 2023' (21 Nov 2023 – Feb 2024) is an open-call contemporary art exhibition held outdoors for the first time, and the accompanying Richard Mille Art Prize will be awarded to one of the participants.
- 'Fables from East and West' (20 Mar 2024 – 14 Jul 2024) showcases illustrated manuscripts, paintings, and contemporary works to examine the roots and evolution of animal fables from different cultures.
