How to reach

Genting Highlands from Kuala Lumpur



By Bus + Cable Car

(Most popular & budget-friendly)



Take the Go Genting Express Bus from major bus terminals in KL. The bus takes you to Awana Bus Terminal at the base of the hill.



From there, take the scenic Awana Skyway cable car directly to the resort's peak.

By Car, Taxi, or Ride-Hailing

(More expensive)



The drive takes approximately 1 hour.



Taxis and ride-sharing services are readily available but are more expensive.

The Awana Skyway Cable Car

The Awana Skyway is more than just transport—it's an attraction in itself. Gondolas glide above lush rainforest canopies with panoramic valley views.



Skip the lines with VQ (Virtual Queue)

What is VQ?

The Virtual Queue lets you reserve ride time slots on the Genting SkyWorlds app — no waiting in long lines!

How to use it:

- 1. Download the free Genting SkyWorlds mobile app via App Store, Google Play or AppGallery.
- 2. Sign up or log in to the app.
- 3. If you have not signed up, create your Profile and link your entrance tickets by scanning the QR code on your tickets.
- 4. To experience attractions together with friends using the same VQ reservations, create a Group Profile by linking your group members' park tickets. Please ensure that everyone in your group is present at the selected attraction at the stated time.
- 5. Select the attractions or shows that you want to reserve and the time slots that you prefer.
- 6. Confirm your VQ reservations.
- 7. When in the park, head to the designated VQ Entrance at the selected attraction at the stated return time. To verify your VQ reservation, scan the QR code located in the "My VQ Reservations" section in the app or the QR code on your printed VQ reservation pass.
- 8. Join the VQ Entrance and enjoy!

Note - Skytropolis rides do not use Virtual Queue (VQ). All attractions operate with physical standby lines only.


