

Liverpool Pass: Attractions Guidebook

The Beatles Story

What's Included:

Entry to The Beatles Story Exhibition, Discovery Zone, Fab4 Store, and Fab4 Café.

Operating Hours:

- The Discovery Zone is open every Saturday and Sunday 11 am to 3 pm.
- Please note the daily opening and closing times are subject to change, please check the official website calendar for the latest information.

Getting There:

Beatles Story is a 1min walk from City Explorer Stop 1 - Albert Dock (Gower Street).

Location: Britannia Vaults, Royal Albert Dock, Liverpool L3 4AD, United Kingdom

Note: On average, visitors typically spend 1-1.5 hours at the experience.

British Music Experience

What's Included:

Entry to British Music Experience

Operating Hours:

- Throughout March the museum is open Wednesday to Sunday.
- During April and May, the museum is open all week.
- The museum is open 10 am 5 pm.
- Last Entry is at 3:45 pm.

Getting There:

As you get off the City Explorer bus at City Explorer Stop 2 - Pier Head, the British Music Experience (Cunard Building) is directly on your right.

Location: Cunard Building, Liverpool, Merseyside L3 1DS

Note: We recommend allowing at least 75 minutes for your visit.

City Explorer Bus

What's Included:

- Live English-speaking tour guide
- 24-hr hop-on hop-off bus tour
- 11 iconic stops
- Click here to view all the stops.

First Stop:

City Explorer Stop 1 - Albert Dock (Gower Street). The bus tour officially starts here but you can hop on at any of the 13 designated stops.

Location: Gower Street Bus Stop, Royal Albert Dock

Note: The tour takes approximately one hour if you stay on from the first to the last stop, but we highly recommend disembarking at each stop to enjoy the most of your time in the city!

Liverpool Football Club

LFC is located outside of the city center in Anfield. Public transport is an easy and efficient way to reach the stadium and we recommend you plan your route in advance.

What's Included:

Entry to the Museum and Exhibitions

Operating Hours:

- Daily from 10 am to 3 pm.
- On matchdays, the museum closes 30 minutes before the kick-off time and the last admission to the museum is 1 hour before kick-off.
- Stadium Tours are not available on Christmas day, Boxing day, New Year's day, the Anniversary of the Hillsborough Disaster, or for any sponsor or charitable event.

Getting There:

Take the 26 bus from Liverpool ONE Bus Station or the 17 from Queen Square Bus Station Location: Liverpool FC Museum, Anfield Stadium, Walton Breck Road, Anfield, Liverpool, L4 0TH

Note: Visitors typically spend 45 minutes to an hour per visit.

River Explorer Cruise

What's Included:

River Explorer Cruise

Operating Hours:

Getting There:

As you get off the City Explorer bus at City Explorer Stop 2 - Pier Head, the Ferry Terminal (Pier Head) is directly on your left.

Location: Pier Head, Liverpool, L3 1DP

Note: Cruises last 50 minutes and depart on the hour.

Strawberry Field

Strawberry Field is located outside of the City Centre in South Liverpool. Public transport is an easy and efficient way to reach the stadium and we recommend you plan your route in advance.

What's Included:

Entry to Strawberry Field

Operating Hours:

- Tue to Sun from 10 am to 5 pm

Getting There:

Take the 75, 76, or 86C bus from Liverpool ONE Bus Station. The journey takes less than an hour.

Location: Beaconsfield Rd, Liverpool, L25 6EJ

Note: The exhibition and garden tour contains over 4.5 hours of meaningful and inspiring content, however, visitors typically spend 1.5 hours at Strawberry Field.
