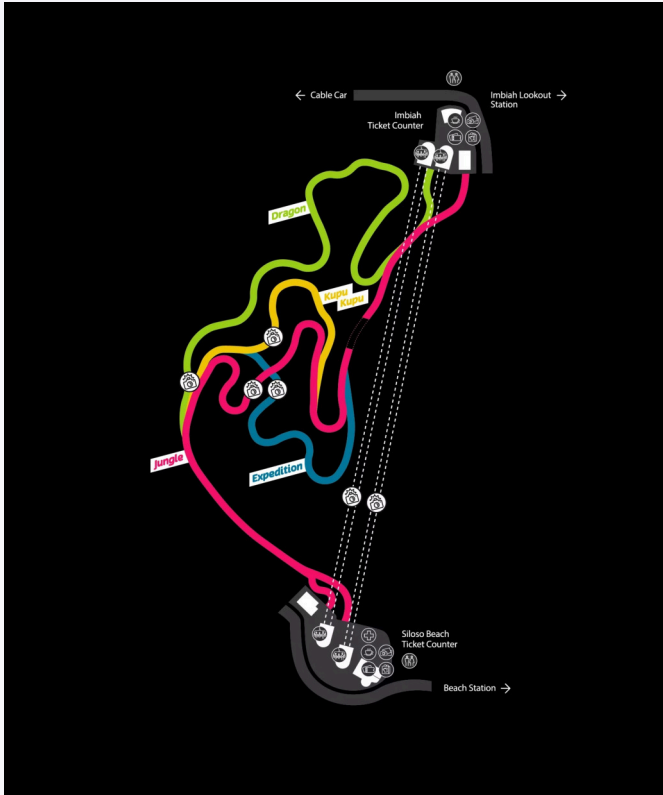


Skyline Luge Tracks



- **Track Selection Process:** Check simplified map of Skyline Luge Sentosa's four color-coded tracks (Jungle, Dragon, Kupu Kupu, Expedition), all starting from the Imbiah Lookout launch point and ending near the Siloso Beach area.
- **Pick at the top:** Buy any ticket → ride the Skyride up → choose one of the four colour-coded lanes (Jungle ●, Dragon ●, Kupu Kupu ●, Expedition ●). No track is assigned in advance; just join the lane you want.
- **Mix & match:** Multi-ride passes let you switch or repeat tracks each run. Try all four or loop your favourite, your wristband simply counts rides.
- **Which track to ride?** Choosing a track can depend on your group and what kind of experience you're after. The following table below offers a quick guide to which Luge track is best for different visitor types or preferences.

Track	Description	Length	Difficulty level	Ideal visitor type & why
Jungle Trail	Family-friendly course with gentle curves, a leafy tunnel and broad straights for easy braking and overtaking.	628 m	Easy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Families with young kids, nervous first-timers• Smooth gradients and simple turns build confidence while still delivering that first-ride “wow”.
Kupu Kupu Trail	Scenic “butterfly” track weaving through lush forest; wide bends and flowing S-curves create a relaxed, glide-like ride.	638 m	Easy-Moderate	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• First-timers & guests who wants epic views• Perfect for riders who want a mellow cruise focused on scenery rather than speed.
Expedition Trail	Fast rainforest route featuring two tunnels, sharper switchbacks and steeper drops for an extra adrenaline kick.	658 m	Moderate-Thrilling	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Thrill-seekers & teens• Offers the most varied terrain and pace changes without being extreme; great mid-level challenge.
Dragon Trail	Longest, twist-heavy course with dramatic hairpins and a themed “dragon” tunnel; feels like a mini roller-coaster.	688 m	Thrilling	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Repeat visitors & speed-fans maximum length means more racing time and tighter corners for those chasing a bigger rush.
