INTRODUCTION

We are glad you are here! At Six Flags Great America we are proud to have earned one of the best safety records in the industry. We are committed to providing our Guests with a safe environment and we want our Guests to have a safe and enjoyable day. We are continually striving to improve our facilities.

Many amusement park rides incorporate safety systems designed by the manufacturer to accommodate people of average physical stature and body proportion. These safety systems may place restrictions on the ability of an individual to safely experience the ride. Guests of larger or smaller size, Guests who have a history of heart, back or neck trouble, Guests who are pregnant, Guests who have had recent surgery, or Guests with casts, braces, restrictive devices or disabilities may not be safely accommodated by these systems. For example, height requirements are based on the size needed for the safety restraints to function properly and the level of maturity usually associated with a certain height.

The Attraction Accessibility Program has been developed using our past experiences and our evaluation of each ride in both normal and emergency operating conditions. We also work closely with the manufacturer of each ride and our policies incorporate the manufacturers' guidelines as well as the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. We hope that this Guide will help Guests make the best choices to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience at the park. Our goal is to safely and efficiently accommodate the needs of all Guests, including individuals with disabilities.

Our prime consideration is the ability of each person to endure the dynamics of a ride without risk of injury to that person or other riders. If you have a suggestion for an improvement or have questions not answered in this brochure, please stop at Guest Relations. If you feel that you or a member of your party may be affected by this policy, you are encouraged to visit the Ride Information Center to obtain a list of rides you can safely ride. Your Rider Access Form will provide information for our Team Member to help accommodate you.

RIDE SAFELY

While all amusement attractions have associated risks, certain individuals are at increased risk for injury from these attractions.

Carefully evaluate each attraction to determine if you or members of your party can safely participate. We reserve the right to deny access to a ride to anyone who we feel may not be able to safely experience the ride or may be a hazard to other Riders.

A Safety Guide sign is posted at every ride entrance and Alternate Access entrance. These signs provide height requirements, health restrictions, ride ratings, ride accessibility, and special instructions regarding the ride. Please review these signs prior to accessing the ride and ensure to follow all instructions provided.

In general, all Guests should be in good health and free from any conditions known or unknown, that might be aggravated by riding. If you have any doubt about your ability to safely experience a ride, we urge you to consult with our staff at Six Flags Great America. Remember, if you suspect your health could be at risk for any reason, or you could aggravate a pre-existing condition of any kind, **do not ride.**

Generally, Guests must have the ability to brace themselves upright in the seat and support their head and neck during the ride movements. Guests using wheelchairs will have to transfer from their wheelchair to the ride unit by themselves or assisted by a member of their party in order to be able to ride. You should plan your visit with someone who can physically help you when necessary.

As a Guest, you are responsible for your own safety. Please read this guide and all instructional signage before riding. Listen to and follow all operator instructions. Any person who intentionally removes a safety restraint, violates a park safety policy, or appears to be under the influence of alcohol or chemical intoxicants will be removed from the park without refund. **FOR YOUR SAFETY, DO NOT ENTER AN UNAUTHORIZED AREA FOR ANY REASON.** You may be seriously injured if you enter an unauthorized area.

Before riding, please note all safety warnings for each ride. In general:

- Follow all proper rider positioning until the ride comes to a complete stop.
- All restraint systems, including lap bars, shoulder harnesses, and seatbelts, must be positioned, fastened, and tightened at all times.

- Due to the nature of our rides, backpacks, purses, electronics, stuffed animals, jewelry and other loose items are not permitted on most rides. Glasses must be secured. Smaller items may be secured in cargo pockets or waist packs as long as they do not interfere with the restraint system. In addition, smaller items may be left in a locker or with a non-Rider. Six Flags Great America is not responsible for lost or stolen items. You are responsible for your personal property.

- Due to the nature of our rides, picture taking, cell phone or electronic usage while riding is prohibited on most rides.

- Keep all parts of your body inside the ride unit at all times.

- Shirt, shoes, and shorts/pants are required on most amusement park rides.

- Finish food and drink before boarding.

- Smoking, including e-cigarettes, is not permitted in Six Flags Great America.

DEFINITIONS

Every ride entrance lists height requirements and special instructions regarding the ride. Six Flags uses the following terms:

Supervising Companion: a Companion who is at least 54" in height and approximately 14 years of age, who meets all other criteria for riding, and who will assist their Companion in complying with safe participation instructions.

Hand-Held Infant: A lap child is a child who is unable to walk to the ride independently or maintain independent seated postural control.

Ability to Hold on or Brace: Ability to use one's arms to maintain a grasp on an assist bar and support one's body during normal and emergency procedures on a ride and to use one's legs to brace to maintain a seated position during the ride.

Accompanied By: Whenever a Guest needs accompaniment, the accompanying person must meet all the ride requirements and be able to assist the Guest including helping the Guest to board and exit the ride and assisting the Guest down stairs, catwalks, or ladders in case of an evacuation

HEALTH RESTRICTIONS



Each ride is evaluated against 5 primary health restrictions. These restrictions are:

- Back Trouble
- Heart Trouble/High Blood Pressure
- Neck Trouble
- Pregnancy
- Recent Surgery

If you are in doubt about your ability to safely experience a ride or would like more information, please review the information for each attraction in this Guest Accessibility Guide or review the Safety Guide and all warning signs posted at each ride entrance and Alternate Access Entrances.

PREGNANCY

Guests who know or believe they may be pregnant should follow all rules, guidelines and restrictions listed for each ride. Those who are pregnant should not ride a ride that specifically lists pregnancy as a rider restriction. Please closely review all rules and guidelines at the entrance of each ride.

HEIGHT REQUIREMENTS

Height requirements and specific instructions are posted at the entrance to each attraction. Guests may be "officially" measured at the Ride Information Center. The measured Guest will be given a wristband to indicate their height range. Wristbands are not required to ride. They are intended to make your wait in line shorter by streamlining the Guest height measurement process.

To accurately measure Guests, a height measuring device may be used during the height measuring process. This device may come into contact with the Guest's head for a brief period.

For the safety of Guests, a shoe which does not contribute excessively to the Guest's height is required. For example, a Guest is not permitted to wear platform shoes to help meet a height

requirement. Six Flags Great America reserves the right to ask that shoes be removed to ensure that a Guest's height is not being artificially enhanced or manipulated.

ATTRACTION ACCESSIBILITY PROGRAM

We are proud of our reputation for accommodating Guests with disabilities through our Attraction Accessibility Program. To provide equal access for all Guests, we have developed a program which allows Guests with mobility restrictions or cognitive impairment to access attractions. Information about where Guests access the ride is posted on each attraction's Safety Guide sign. All Guests are required to meet all riding requirements for every attraction, including height and health restrictions in order to safely ride/participate.

The Guest with a mobility restriction or cognitive impairment should visit the Ride Information Center upon their arrival at the park to express their inability to wait in the regular line. Some questions are asked to ensure that the Guest has the required physical criteria in order to safely experience attractions. Following that conversation, the Guest Relations Team Member will provide the details needed to participate in the program. If qualified, all members of the party must be present to receive the Attraction Accessibility Pass.

Guests with mobility restrictions or cognitive impairments who request reasonable accommodations are encouraged to obtain the IBCCES Accessibility Card (IAC) by registering at accessibilitycard.org or via the Accessibility Card mobile App. Once a Guest has filled out the online application and uploaded necessary documentation into a secure online portal, they will be able to access their digital Accessibility Card. Guests will present the IBCCES Accessibility Card to Six Flags Great America upon their arrival at the park to express their accommodation needs. Some questions are asked to ensure that the Guest has the required physical criteria in order to safely experience attractions. Following that conversation, the Guest Relations Team Member will provide the details needed to participate in the program. If qualified, all members of the party must be present to receive the Attraction Accessibility Pass.

Note: Only IBCCES can issue the IBCCES Accessibility Card, and not Six Flags Great America.

CASTS & BRACES

Guests with casts and braces will be restricted from riding rides where the cast or brace will not fit inside the ride unit or where it will present a hazard to the Guest or others. Guests with full arm (elbow restricted) and full leg (knee restricted) casts or braces are restricted from most rides and water slides. We suggest you delay your visit until the cast is removed.

PROSTHETIC DEVICES

Guests with any type of prosthesis should not ride unless they can ensure the device is properly secured and will remain in place during the ride. If there is any concern of the prosthesis becoming dislodged during the ride, Guests should visit the Ride Information Center for assistance.

Guests with leg prostheses are not permitted to ride BATMAN: The Ride, Raging Bull, SUPERMAN: Ultimate Flight, Wrath of Rakshasa, and X Flight.

Guests with any prosthesis are not permitted to ride Giant Drop, Goliath, Maxx Force, Sky Striker, THE FLASH: Vertical Velocity, THE JOKER Free-Fly Coaster.

Guests with certain amputations may be able to all rides with the exception of AQUAMAN Splashdown, Logger's Run, Roaring Rapids, and Rue Le Dodge with the use of a separate full body harness provided the Guest has remaining leg and arm remnants to be secured by the harness. Guests should check with the Ride Information Center to determine if they are eligible to ride using the full body harness.

On BATMAN: The Ride, Raging Bull, SUPERMAN: Ultimate Flight, Wrath of Rakshasa, and X Flight Guests with any upper extremity prosthesis must ensure the device is properly secured or removed prior to riding.

RIDE DEVICES

Guests with disabilities may be eligible to ride select attractions using a body harness provided by the park. Guests should visit designated park locations for assistance and to determine eligibility.

For safety reasons, certain attractions may require the removal of medical devices or prosthetics that are not securely fastened to the rider's body. These devices may interfere with safety restraints,

prevent proper riding posture, or pose hazards to the Guest or others.

On rides equipped with removable seats, Guests using wheelchairs may transfer directly to the ride vehicle. Ride attendants and Guest service staff are available to assist with questions or specific requirements regarding harnesses, mobility aids, or prosthetic devices.

Safety is the park's highest priority. To ensure an enjoyable and safe experience, Guests who do not meet specific rider requirements, including those related to harnesses and mobility aids, may be restricted from participating.

Additional lists are available for:

- Body Harnesses, when requested, allow certain Guests with disabilities the ability to ride if they meet the ride criteria. The following rides are equipped with a body harness: **American Eagle, Batman: The Ride, Big Easy Balloons, Bouncer, Chubasco, Columbia Carousel (if they want to ride on an animal), Crazy Bus, DC Super-Villains Swing, Demon, Fiddler's Fling, Giant Drop, Goliath, Hometown Fun Machine, Justice League Battle for Metropolis, Krazy Kars, Krazy Kups, Lady Bugs, Little Dipper, Lady Bugs, Maxx Force, Raging Bull, Red Baron, Ricochet, River Rocker, Sky Striker, Sporcket Rockets, Superman Ultimate Flight, The Dark Knight Coaster, The Flash: Vertical Velocity, The Joker, The Lobster, Tot's Livery, Triple Play, Up Up & Away, Viper, Whizzer, Winner's Circle, X Flight, Zoomjets**

For additional guidance, Guests are encouraged to consult the park guide or speak with a Ride Attendant or Guest Relations team member.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Our goal is to make Six Flags Great America as enjoyable and barrier-free as practical. Listed below are some of the services we offer. Please feel free to suggest areas in which we might improve in the future.

FRIGHT FEST

Theatrical fog effects, areas of low lighting, loud music, sound effects, and theatrical and strobe lighting are used throughout the Park during Fright Fest. This includes streets, midways, outdoor

scare zones, mazes and haunted houses both indoor and outdoor, live entertainment venues and children's attractions.

Guests with respiratory sensitivities, history of seizures or epilepsy, or sensitivities to latex, loud music and sound effects are advised not to participate in these attractions. Please adhere to all posted and verbal warnings and directions.

PARKING

Accessible parking is available on a first-come, first-served basis within the main parking lots of the park. When you arrive at the parking toll booths, ask a Team Member for instructions regarding where to proceed to the accessible parking lot. Both auto and van accessible spaces are provided. A valid disabled persons parking placard or license plate must be displayed at all times while parked in the designated accessible parking area. If the designated accessible parking area is full at the time of your arrival, members of your party may be dropped off at the main pick-up/drop-off area, near the main entrance to the park. Proper vehicle identification must be displayed. Security Officers on duty are authorized to ticket and/or tow vehicles that do not display proper identification. Please ask a Team Member for directions to additional parking areas.

WHEELCHAIRS AND ELECTRIC CONVENIENCE VEHICLES (ECVs)

A limited supply of wheelchairs, electric convenience vehicles (ECV), and strollers are available for rent at Stroller & Wheelchair rental in Carousel Plaza. However, since wheelchairs, ECV's, and strollers are rented on a first-come, first-served basis and cannot be reserved in advance, we urge Guests to bring their own. Rentals are also available at the park while supplies last. Wheelchairs, ECV's, and strollers may not be taken out of the park gates or to the parking lot.

Guests who choose to use a wheelchair or ECV, we require a safe speed be maintained while traveling in the park. Wheelchairs and ECV's cannot be accommodated on most rides and attractions. If in doubt about your ability to safely experience a ride, we urge you to consult with our staff at Guest Relations or the Ride Information Center.

Six Flags Great America personnel are not trained in transferring Guests from wheelchairs to ride units and are not permitted to do so. You should plan your visit with someone who can physically help you

when necessary. Guests may re-charge their wheelchair battery at Guest Relations.

SEGWAY

Due to varying walkways, terrains and large crowds, we cannot permit the use of two-wheeled, self-balancing electric vehicles such as Segways. We are pleased to offer other forms of transportation, including ECV's and standard wheelchairs. Please contact Guest Relations for more information.

SERVICE ANIMALS

Service animals are welcome at Six Flags Great America. A service animal is defined as a dog that has been individually trained to perform tasks for a person with disabilities. Service animals must be controlled with a restraining device and must display appropriate behavior at all times while on our property. There is a limit of one service animal per Guest. A relief area is located next to THE JOKER Free-Fly Coaster's exit in Mardi Gras .

Due to the nature of most rides, service animals must remain with a non-riding member of your party. We are not permitted to take control of your service animal. Guests may take advantage of our Rider Swap policy for staying with the service animal. Service animals may be taken on Columbia Carousel, Crazy Bus, Great America Scenic Railway, Sky Trek Tower, and Up, Up, & Away. Service animals must be leashed, under the owner's control, fit on the floor of the ride vehicle, and seated on the floor, not the ride seat.

Service animals are not permitted in water attractions, wet decks, wading pools, or lazy rivers. They are permitted to walk through the park areas, including scare zones. Visit Guest Services or refer to our Guest Accessibility Guide for more information.

A Service Animal "Relief Area" is located in the grassy area alongside THE JOKER in Mardi Gras and near the restrooms at the Front Gate. Owners are responsible for disposing of their animal's waste. Please look for this designated sign:



RESTROOMS

Most restrooms within the Park are accessible for Guests using wheelchairs. Please check the Park map for locations. The Park's Team Members or Guest Relations can provide location directions should you need companion restrooms during your visit.

MEDICAL DEVICES AND MOBILITY AIDES

For your safety and the safety of others, riders may be required to remove medical devices, half- or full-length orthotics, braces, crutches, canes, prosthetics and any other type of medical assistance device that is not permanently affixed to the rider's body to prevent hazards or loss due to ride forces. These devices prevent safety restraints from working as designed, keep the rider from maintaining the proper riding posture, and present a hazard to the rider or others. If in doubt about your ability to safely experience a ride or attraction, please refer to the Rider Requirement Sign at the ride entrance. You may also consult with a Ride Attendant or Guest Relations for more information.

Please also refer to the "Ride Information" section of this Guide for specific information regarding removal of medical devices and mobility aides on a ride by ride basis. If you have any questions, please ask a Ride Attendant or visit Guest Relations.

RIDER SWAP

The Rider Swap program allows one adult to stay with non-riders while the rest enjoy the ride. Upon their return, they can switch with the waiting adult, who can ride without joining the regular queue. For more information, visit Guest Services near Hometown Square.

FAMILY SERVICES/NURSING MOTHERS

A space for nursing mothers is available at First Aid in Hometown Square and Kidzopolis in County Fair. Baby changing areas and a companion restroom can be found in most restrooms. Please feel free to ask a Team Member for directions to these locations or review a park map.

HEARING DISABILITIES

Assisted listening devices are available upon request. Please see Guest Relations for additional information.

American Sign Language Interpreting will be available if requested at least 7 days in advance of your visit. To arrange for sign language interpreting services, please call 847-249-4636 Monday through Friday 9:00am to 5:00pm.

VISUAL IMPAIRMENTS

Guest with Visual Impairments - Guests with Visual Impairments that require assistance from a family member, friend, companion and or an aid (Care Attendant) will be provided a complimentary ticket for their Care Attendant. The Guest & Care Attendant should visit Guest Relations to obtain the complimentary ticket after a ticket is purchased by the Guest. The requirement to obtain the complimentary ticket is as follows: the Guest would have to present a valid doctor's note in order to receive the complimentary ticket for the Care Attendant. The doctor's note must include the name of the persons requesting the complimentary ticket, the doctor's name, address, phone number and their signature on their letterhead that includes their medical ID number, along with a statement indicating the Guest has a disability or other qualifying impairment under the Americans with disabilities Act (ADA).

SPECIAL DIETARY NEEDS

Although outside food and beverages are not allowed in the park, individuals who have special diets or need items due to a medical condition may bring small coolers to accommodate such needs. Please visit Guest Services for more information.

FIRST AID:

Our First Aid Building/Station/Center located in Hometown Square is staffed from park open to park close. Medical equipment storage and refrigeration for Guests with medication is offered at First Aid.

RIDE INFORMATION

CAMERAS

Picture taking and the use of cameras and video recording devices is not permitted on any ride, while it is in motion. It is encouraged that Guests leave their equipment with a non-rider or secure it in a locker or their vehicle. Lockers are available to store items for a nominal fee. Guests must have written permission to use photographs and/or recordings of any aspect of the Park for commercial broadcasting, advertising, marketing, or publishing in any medium.

RIDE EVACUATIONS

Evacuations may be required due to mechanical reasons, weather conditions, or a power interruption. If an evacuation is required, Riders may need to maneuver across catwalks, from the highest point of the ride, and down steeply inclined catwalks or steps. Ride units may also stop at the top of a lift or on the ride course. Certain evacuations may require Riders to use additional safety equipment during the process. Remain seated until given instructions. If an evacuation from a ride/attraction is required, Riders requiring assistance during the ride evacuation may be escorted last in order to expedite the ride evacuation process. If so, you accept any risk due to delayed evacuation if we need to physically lift or lower you.

LARGER FRAMED GUESTS

All restraint systems, including lap bars, shoulder harnesses, and seatbelts must be positioned and fastened properly to allow Guests to ride. Due to restraint system requirements, Guests of larger size (in terms of height, weight, and/or proportions) may not be accommodated on some of our rides.

Maximum [and minimum] weight limits can be found under the individual rides in this guide and on the Rider Safety Guide Signs at the entrance to rides with restrictions.

If you are concerned whether or not you can be accommodated safely on a ride, you may enter the ride via the exit to ensure the

restraints function properly prior to waiting in line. The rest of your party may wait for you outside the exit.

Test seats are located at the ride entrance(s) of:
Superman: Ultimate Flight, The Joker, Batman: The Ride, Goliath, Raging Bull, and X-Flight

The manufacturer requires a maximum Guest height on the following rides:

- Sky Striker – 80”
- The Joker – 77”
- The Flash: Vertical Velocity – 80”
- Red Baron – 54”
- Tot’s Livery – 54”
- Lady Bugs – 54”
- Yahoo Rover – 54”
- X Flight – 78”

LOOSE ARTICLE POLICY

Most rides cannot accommodate loose articles including jewelry, cell phones, hats, cameras, purses, backpacks, basketballs, umbrellas, beverage containers, electronic devices, etc. Items must be safely secured in cargo pockets, a waist pack, in a bin on the ride platform, in a locker, or with a non-Rider. Six Flags Great America is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.

Extra or bulky clothing, backpacks, and anything else that could potentially be between the Rider and the restraint will not be allowed. The restraint mechanism must be secured snugly against the Rider's body.

For safety reasons, cell phone usage, taking pictures and filming on rides are prohibited.

Glasses must be secured on all rides.

Hearing devices and other electronic devices may be damaged by water at water rides and attractions. Please take necessary precautions to protect hearing devices on all rides. Sensory headphones or helmets may be accommodated on select rides. Please see a Team Member for more details.

Any non-compliance which results in damage or injury to a person or property will result in consequences up to and including prosecution.

LOST & FOUND

All items found at Six Flags Great America are turned in to Lost and Found located at the Main Gate. If you lose an item on a ride, we will search for the article as soon as possible. In order to keep the ride in operation, an immediate search may not be possible.

FOR YOUR SAFETY, DO NOT ENTER UNAUTHORIZED AREAS TO RETRIEVE LOST ARTICLES. You can be seriously injured if you enter an unauthorized area.

OXYGEN TANKS/AIR CONCENTRATORS

Due to the dynamic nature of rides, Portable Oxygen Tanks are only permitted on the following rides: **Columbia Carousel, Great America Scenic Railway, Sky Trek Tower, and Justice League: Battle for Metropolis.** The tank must fit safely in the ride unit and not interfere with the ride restraint system. For your convenience, the park’s First Aid station(s) will be able to appropriately store your additional oxygen tanks during your visit.

Many rides can accommodate smaller Personal Oxygen Equipment. Personal Oxygen Equipment that can be secured around the waist, or with a strap that can be worn over the shoulder of one arm and under the other arm, may be permitted as long as the contents of the equipment housing can be contained. The equipment must allow the restraint mechanism to be secured snugly against the Rider's body. The equipment must not prevent Riders from properly sitting in the ride unit with their back and shoulders against the seat back. At no time may the equipment be between the Rider and the seat or the restraint. Riders must be free to hold on during the ride; therefore, nothing may be in their hands while riding.

MAGNETIC FIELDS ON RIDES

Magnetics are used at the following attractions: **The Dark Knight Coaster, X Flight, Justice League: Battle for Metropolis, The Flash: Vertical Velocity, Giant Drop, Goliath, The Joker, Maxx Force, Wrath of Rakshasa.** Guests with medical devices sensitive to magnetic fields (pacemakers, hearing aids, etc.), should consider these factors when deciding to ride.

STROBE LIGHTING & SPECIAL EFFECTS

Many attractions utilize special effects, including but not limited to: haze and other atmospheric effects, scents, areas of low lighting, loud music, sound effects, strobe lighting and other specialty lighting. Guests with medical conditions that may be impacted by these special effects are advised not to participate in these attractions. Attractions utilizing these effects include: **Justice League: Battle for Metropolis. During Fright Fest: Chubasco and Rue Le Dodge.**

PROPER ATTIRE

For the safety and enjoyment of our guests, everyone is to adhere to proper dress attire, as most rides require each Guest ride with shirts, shorts and shoes. Loose clothing (including scarves and other free-flowing clothing) must be fully secured or removed to prevent any interference with the ride restraint system. Loose clothing (including scarves, ponchos, and other free-flowing clothing), must be significantly secured or removed to prevent any interference with the ride restraint system. On **Winner's Circle**, loose clothing will be required to be removed in their entirety. Loose fitting shoes may only be removed before riding **American Eagle, Batman: The Ride, Demon, Fiddler's Fling, Giant Drop, Little Dipper, Raging Bull, Sky Striker, Sprocket Rockets, Superman Ultimate Flight, The Flash: Vertical Velocity, The Joker, Viper, X Flight**

RIDER CRITERIA

Our Attraction Accessibility Program is designed to allow Guests to participate in the enjoyment of our attractions as much as possible. The program was developed by analyzing the physical and mental attributes required to safely ride each attraction. It is our policy to allow anyone to ride who meets all these requirements and is not a hazard to themselves or others. We continue to evaluate and update our Attraction Accessibility Program as necessary.

The evaluation of each attraction considered the following criteria:

Independent seated postural.

The Guest must have the body and spinal control to sit upright without the aid of other people or devices. The Guest must also have sufficient muscle control to support their head, neck and upper torso during the course of the ride, including the dynamic motion of the ride. Certain ride units such as carousel horses require the ability to form a saddle posture with the Guest's thighs.

Appropriate center of gravity.

The Guest's body must have the appropriate weight distribution for that ride.

Ability to hold on with one functioning arm.

Guests must have one functioning arm that exhibits good grip control, the ability to brace, and is strong enough to allow the Guest to maintain proper riding position throughout the duration of the ride. A functioning arm may be a natural arm or a prosthesis which can be used for gripping and bracing. Any arm prosthesis must remain properly secured under the dynamic forces of the ride. Due to manufacturer requirements, some rides may exclude prosthesis.

Ability to hold on with two functioning arms.

Guests must have two functioning arms that exhibit good grip control, the ability to brace, and are strong enough to allow the Guest to maintain the proper riding position throughout the duration of the ride. A functioning arm may be a natural arm or a prosthesis which can be used for gripping and bracing. Any arm prosthesis must remain properly secured under the dynamic forces of the ride. Due to manufacturer requirements, some rides may exclude prosthesis.

Ability to brace self with one functioning leg.

Guests must have one functioning leg to be used for bracing the body during the course of the ride. A functioning leg may be a natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit. Any leg prosthesis must remain properly secured under the dynamic forces of the ride. Due to manufacturer requirements, some rides may exclude prosthesis.

Ability to brace self with two functioning legs.

Guests must have two functioning legs to be used for bracing the body during the course of the ride. A functioning leg may be a natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit. Any leg prosthesis must remain properly secured under the dynamic forces of the ride. Due to manufacturer requirements, some rides may exclude prosthesis.

Minimum of two functioning extremities.

Guests must have a minimum of two functioning extremities (two legs, two arms, or one arm and one leg) to brace themselves during the ride and assist in entering and exiting the ride unit.

Minimum of three functioning extremities.

Guests must have a minimum of three functioning extremities (two legs and one arm or two arms and one leg) to brace themselves (with tripod bracing) during the ride and assist in entering and exiting the ride unit.

Minimum of four functioning extremities.

Guests must have four functioning extremities (two legs and two arms) to brace themselves during the ride and assist in entering and exiting the ride unit.

Ability to enter/exit ride within specified parameters without endangering self or others.

Guests must be able to enter and exit the ride without jeopardizing themselves or others and to assist with their own evacuation, if necessary. This may include special arrangements such as entering through the Alternate Access Entrance or having someone aid in boarding. For the safety of our Team Members and Guests, Associates are instructed not to perform any lifting of Guests.

Appropriate observed behavior:

Guest demonstrates appropriate observed behavior indicating a willingness and ability to participate and/or follow Guest requirements. Appropriate observed behavior may include, but not be limited to maintaining proper riding position, attention and compliance to safety instructions, proper use of all ride safety equipment and willingness to participate.

Guests have a duty to:

- Exercise good judgment
- Act in a responsible manner while using amusement rides
- Not participate while under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- Properly use all ride safety equipment provided

RIDES

The following descriptions are designed to give you information on the type of actions caused by various rides. Each of the following attractions will identify the restrictions according to the criteria itemized above. **In order to participate on most attractions, Guests must have seated postural control, appropriate center of gravity, appropriate observed behavior, and the ability to enter**

and exit the ride safely. Specific exceptions or qualifications to those four criteria will be noted in the information provided below. If you have been authorized for Alternate Access, follow the directions listed under each ride.

WARNING

There are inherent risks in participating in any amusement attraction. If you choose to participate, you accept these risks and agree to do so responsibly. Read all important safety information prior to riding and obey all posted and verbal instructions. For your protection, each attraction is rated for its special features including height, speed, direction, and dynamic forces. You know your physical conditions and limitations, Six Flags Great America does not. If you suspect your health could be at risk, or you could aggravate any pre-existing condition, **do not ride!**

All restraint systems, including lap bars, shoulder harnesses and seatbelts, must be positioned, fastened and tightened properly to allow Guests to ride.

Information in this guide is subject to changes.

American Eagle

An exciting roller coaster with high speed turns and steep drops and sudden stops.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 48" tall to ride.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit) to ride. Riders can also possess two functioning arm extremities and two functioning leg extremities that include a knee. For your safety and the safety of others, riders must remove medical devices including crutches, canes, prosthesis and any other type of medical assistance device that is not permanently affixed to the rider's body to prevent hazards or loss due to ride forces. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV (or a member of their party) should proceed up the exit ramp and present a valid Attraction Accessibility Pass to a Team Member at the exit to receive a wait time.

AQUAMAN: Splashdown

A family boat ride with turns, drops, and splashes.

Height Restriction: Riders under 42" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Personal flotation devices may be requested prior to boarding the ride. Please see the ride attendant for more information.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a boat) to ride. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should proceed up the exit and present a valid Attraction Accessibility Pass to a Team Member at the exit to receive a wait time. This ride was constructed before the Americans with Disabilities Act and is only accessible via stairs.

BATMAN: The Ride

An exciting roller coaster with high speeds, steep drops, fast turns, inverted loops, and sudden stops.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 54" tall to ride.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders with one amputated foot or two amputated feet (amputation below the knee), with or without prosthesis, may ride provided the rider has the ability to hold on with two functioning hands. Riders with one missing arm or hand may ride, provided the rider has the ability to hold on with one functioning hand and brace themselves with two functioning legs. For your safety and the safety of others, riders must remove medical devices including crutches, canes, leg prosthesis and any other type of medical assistance device that is not permanently affixed to the rider's body to prevent hazards or loss due to ride forces. Arm/leg casts are not permitted on the ride. Arm prosthesis are permitted as long as they are properly secured under the dynamic forces of the ride. Riders using a wheelchair must transfer from the wheelchair onto the ride. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV (or a member of their party) should proceed up the exit ramp and present a valid Attraction Accessibility Pass to a Team Member at the exit to receive a wait time.

Big Easy Balloons

A family ride with circulating motion with frequent stops.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 48" tall to ride alone. Riders under 48" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm or a prosthesis which can be used for gripping and bracing) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit) to ride. Riders must step up and down into an elevated ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.

Bouncer (Kidzopolis)

A ride with a mild up and down motion.

Height Restriction: Riders under 36" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing and must include a hand) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit) to ride. Leg casts are not permitted on this ride. Riders must step up and down into an elevated ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.

Chubasco

A moderate ride with a quick circulating motion.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 42" tall to ride alone. Riders under 42" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing and must include a hand) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit. Must include a foot) to ride. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride entrance.

Columbia Carousel

A ride that slowly moves in a circular manner with a mild up and down motion.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 42" tall to ride alone. Riders under 42" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Lap children are permitted to ride with a rider over 54" tall in a chariot. Riders over 54" tall standing next to children must stand to the inside of the carousel figure.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride. Riders who cannot maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm or a prosthesis which can be used for gripping and bracing) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit), and one leg extremity to the knee in order to ride on an animal. Riders must step up and down onto the ride and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride. Some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride on an animal.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.

Condor

A moderate ride that spins and tilts to the top of an elevated tower.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 54" tall to ride alone. Riders under 54" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm or a prosthesis which can be used for gripping and bracing) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit) to ride. Riders must step up and down into an elevated ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.

Crazy Bus (Camp Cartoon)

A gentle ride with circular up and down motion.

Height Restriction: Riders must be 36" tall to ride alone. Riders under 36" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing and must include a hand) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit. Must include a foot) to ride. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.

THE DARK KNIGHT Coaster

An exciting roller coaster with sudden turns and drops.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 42" tall to ride. Riders between 42" tall and 48" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. A rider over 54" tall may accompany one rider between 42" tall and 48" tall and must sit in the same row.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm or a prosthesis which can be used for gripping and bracing) and two complete leg extremities (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit) to ride. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV (or a member of their party) should proceed to the exit and present a valid Attraction Accessibility Pass to a Team Member to receive a wait time. In order to ride, proceed to the marked entrance with the universal wheelchair symbol.

DC Super-Villains Swing

A moderate ride with quick circular motion.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 48" tall to ride.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm or a prosthesis which can be used for gripping and bracing) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit) to ride. Riders must step up and down into an elevated ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.

Demon

A high speed roller coaster with high speed and multiple inversions.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 48" tall to ride.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm or a prosthesis which can be used for gripping and bracing) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit) to ride. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV (or a member of their party) should proceed up the exit ramp and present a valid Attraction Accessibility Pass to a Team Member at the exit to receive a wait time.

Fiddler's Fling

A ride with circulating and spinning motions.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 42" tall to ride alone. Riders under 42" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm or a prosthesis which can be used for gripping and bracing) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit) to ride. Riders can also possess two functioning arm extremities and two functioning leg extremities that include a knee. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride entrance.

THE FLASH: Vertical Velocity

An intense roller coaster with quick acceleration, high speeds, steep drops, fast turns, and inverted turns.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 52" tall and under 80" tall to ride.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess three complete extremities to ride. A complete extremity is a complete arm (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing) or a complete leg (natural leg used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit). For your safety and the safety of others, riders must remove medical devices including crutches, canes, prosthesis and any other type of medical assistance device that is not permanently affixed to the rider's body to prevent hazards or loss due to ride forces. Riders using a wheelchair must transfer from the wheelchair onto the ride. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV (or a member of their party) should proceed up the exit ramp and present a valid Attraction Accessibility Pass to a Team Member at the exit to receive a wait time.

Giant Drop

An exciting elevated ride with a sudden drop.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 48" tall to ride.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm or a prosthesis which can be used for gripping and bracing) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit) to ride. For your safety and the safety of others, riders must remove medical devices including crutches, canes, leg prosthesis and any other type of medical assistance device that is not permanently affixed to the rider's body to prevent hazards or loss due to ride forces. Arm prosthesis are permitted as long as they are properly secured under the dynamic forces of the ride. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV (or a member of their party) should proceed to the gate next to the operator booth and present a valid Attraction Accessibility Pass to the Team Member in the booth to receive a wait time.

Goliath

An exciting roller coaster with high speed turns, steep drops, inversions, and sudden stops.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 48" tall to ride.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing with a hand) and two complete leg extremities (natural leg used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit with a foot) to ride. For your safety and the safety of others, riders must remove medical devices including crutches, canes, prosthesis and any other type of medical assistance device that is not permanently affixed to the rider's body to prevent hazards or loss due to ride forces. Arm/leg casts are not permitted on the ride. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV (or a member of their party) should proceed up the exit ramp and present a valid Attraction Accessibility Pass to a Team Member at the exit to receive a wait time.

Great America Scenic Railway

A family ride that moves around a track with gentle turns.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 42" tall to ride alone. Riders under 42" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Lap children are permitted to ride with a rider over 54" tall.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders who cannot maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.

Hometown Fun Machine

A moderate ride with a quick circulating motion.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 36" tall to ride. Riders between 36" tall and 48" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders with one amputated foot or two amputated feet (amputation below the knee), with or without prosthesis, may ride provided the rider has the ability to hold on with two functioning hands. Riders with one missing arm or hand may ride, provided the rider has the ability to hold on with one functioning hand and brace themselves with one functioning leg. Riders must step up and down into an elevated ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride entrance.

THE JOKER

An exciting, high speed, 4D coaster with drops and flips

HEIGHT RESTRICTION: Riders must be at least 48" tall but no taller than 77" tall to ride this ride. May not exceed 300 lbs.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must be able to remain sitting up straight, keep their head against the headrest, their back and shoulders against the seat back, and their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. In addition, riders must possess one (1) fully functioning arm with the ability to be used for gripping and bracing that includes a hand with three fingers, and two (2) functioning legs that at least include a knee that can be used for maintaining balance when entering and exiting a unit.

Full arm/leg casts are not permitted on this ride (A full arm/leg cast is a cast that restricts the riders ability to bend the elbow/knee in any way). No Prosthesis.

Riders must be able to sit properly, use all restraining devices, and stabilize self. Riders using a wheelchair must transfer from the wheelchair onto the ride. Guest must be able to step up into ride unit.

RIDE ACCESS: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ADA entrance.

JUSTICE LEAGUE: Battle for Metropolis

An interactive dark ride with turns and spins.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 42" tall to ride. Guests between 42" and 48" tall must be accompanied by a supervising companion who is someone who physically and mentally meets all of the requirements to ride, is 14 years of age or older, and exhibits the maturity of someone 14 years of age or older.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Lap seating is not permitted. All passenger restraints, including lap bars, must be fastened properly to allow guest to ride. Due to the restraints some large guests may not be able to ride. Riders must be able to sit properly (facing forward, sitting upright, flat in the seat with their arms and legs inside the ride), use all restraining devices, and stabilize themselves throughout the entire ride cycle in order to ride. Strobe lights are in use. **Extremity Requirement:** Riders must have two (2) natural functioning arms or prosthesis with the ability to grip and brace and at least one (1) natural functioning leg or prosthesis with the ability to brace and maintain balance when entering and exiting the ride unit.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ADA entrance.

Krazy Kars (Kidzopolis)

A ride around a track with gentle turns.

Height Restriction: 36" minimum to ride alone. Riders under 36" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing and must include a hand) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit. Must include a foot) to ride. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.

Krazy Kups (Kidzopolis)

A gentle circular ride.

Height Restriction: 36" minimum to ride alone. Riders under 36" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing and must include a hand) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit. Must include a foot) to ride. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.

Lady Bugs (Hometown Park)

A gentle slow moving circular ride.

Height Restriction: Riders must be 54" tall or below to ride. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Riders must possess upper body control, the ability to sit in an upright position and maintain an upright posture. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing and must include a hand) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit. Must include a foot) to ride. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.

Little Dipper

A family coaster with gentle drops and quick turns.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 36" tall to ride. Riders between 36" tall and 44" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must have three complete extremities to ride. A complete extremity is a complete arm (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing) or a complete leg (natural leg used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit). Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Leg casts are not permitted on the ride. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV (or a member of their party) should proceed up the exit ramp and present a valid Attraction Accessibility Pass to a Team Member at the exit to receive a wait time.

The Lobster

A quick moving circular ride that spins.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 42" tall to ride alone. Riders under 42" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm or a prosthesis which can be used for gripping and bracing) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit) to ride. Riders can also possess two functioning arm extremities and two functioning leg extremities that include a knee. Riders must step up and down into an elevated ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.

Logger's Run

A family boat ride with turns, drops, and splashes.

Height Restriction: Riders under 42" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Personal flotation devices may be requested prior to boarding the ride. Please see the ride attendant for more information.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a boat) to ride. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV (or a member of their party) should proceed up the exit and present a valid Attraction Accessibility Pass to a Team Member at the exit to receive a wait time. This ride was constructed before the Americans with Disabilities Act and is only accessible via stairs.

Maxx Force

An intense roller coaster with quick acceleration, high-speed turns, steep drops, inversions, and sudden stops.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 48" tall to ride. May not exceed 300 lbs.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one (1) natural functioning arm with the ability to grip and brace that includes a hand with three fingers, and two (2) natural functioning legs that can be used for bracing and maintaining balance while entering and exiting the ride unit that include an ankle. For your safety and the safety of others, riders must remove medical devices including crutches, canes, prosthesis and any other type of medical assistance device that is not permanently affixed to the rider's body to prevent hazards or loss due to ride forces. Arm casts are not permitted on the ride. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV (or a member of their party) should proceed through the main entrance and present a valid Attraction Accessibility Pass to a Team Member.

Raging Bull

A high speed roller coaster with high speeds, steep drops, and high banked turns.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 54" tall to ride.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders with one amputated leg or two amputated legs (amputation above the ankle), with or without prosthesis, shall not be allowed on the ride. Riders with one amputated foot or two amputated feet (amputation below the ankle) may ride, provided the rider has the ability to hold on with two functioning hands. Riders with one missing arm or hand may ride, provided the rider has the ability to hold on with one functioning hand and brace themselves with two functioning legs. For your safety and the safety of others, riders must remove medical devices including crutches, canes, leg prosthesis and any other type of medical assistance device that is not permanently affixed to the rider's body to prevent hazards or loss due to ride forces. Arm prosthesis are permitted as long as they are properly secured under the dynamic forces of the ride. Arm/leg casts are not permitted on the ride. Riders using a wheelchair must transfer from the wheelchair onto the ride. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV (or a member of their party) should proceed up the exit ramp and present a valid Attraction Accessibility Pass to a Team Member at the exit to receive a wait time.

Red Baron (Hometown Park)

A gentle slow moving circular ride.

Height Restriction: Riders must be between 36" and 54" tall to ride. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Riders must possess upper body control, the ability to sit in an upright position and maintain an upright posture. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing and must include a hand) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit. Must include a foot) to ride. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.

Ricochet

A moderate ride with a circulating up and down motion.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 42" tall to ride. Riders between 42" tall and 54" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm or a prosthesis which can be used for gripping and bracing) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit) to ride. Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing and must include a hand) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit. Must include a foot) to ride. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. A family raft ride through white water with splashes and turns.

Personal flotation devices may be requested prior to boarding the ride. Please see the ride attendant for more information.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit) to ride. Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm or a prosthesis which can be used for gripping and bracing) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit) to ride. Riders must step up and down into an elevated ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity that includes a forearm and two leg extremities that include a knee to ride. For your safety and the safety of others, riders must remove medical devices including crutches, canes, prosthetics, and any other type of medical assistance device that is not permanently affixed to the rider's body to prevent hazards or loss due to ride forces. Arm/leg casts are not permitted on the ride. Riders using a wheelchair must transfer from the wheelchair onto the ride. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV (or a member of their party) should proceed up the exit ramp and present a valid Attraction Accessibility Pass to a Team Member at the exit to receive a wait time.

Sky Trek Tower

An elevator ride to the viewing area at the top of the ride.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 42" tall to ride alone. Riders under 42" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Lap children are permitted to ride with a rider over 54" tall.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders who cannot maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.

Sprocket Rockets (Camp Cartoon)

A family roller coaster with gentle drops and quick turns.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 36" tall to ride. Riders between 36" and 42" must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess a minimum of one fully formed arm extremity that includes a hand, OR a minimum of two fully formed arm extremities that include a forearm. Riders must also possess one fully formed leg extremity that includes a foot, OR two fully formed leg extremities that include a knee. A complete extremity is a complete arm (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing) or a complete leg (natural leg used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit). Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Leg casts are not permitted on the ride. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.

Splish Splash Zone (Kidzopolis)

Children's water play area.

Height Restriction: None

Physical Requirements: No Restrictions

SUPERMAN: Ultimate Flight

An exciting roller coaster with high speeds, steep drops, fast turns, inverted loops, and sudden stops.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 54" tall to ride.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing) and two complete leg extremities (natural leg used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit. Must include a foot.) to ride. For your safety and the safety of others, riders must remove medical devices including crutches, canes, leg prosthesis and any other type of medical assistance device that is not permanently affixed to the rider's body to prevent hazards or loss due to ride forces. Arm prosthesis are permitted as long as they are properly secured under the dynamic forces of the ride. Arm/leg casts are not permitted on the ride. Riders must possess upper body control, the ability to sit in an upright position and maintain an upright posture. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing and must include a hand) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit. Must include a foot) to ride. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Triple Play

A moderate ride with quick circular motion.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 42" tall to ride. Riders between 42" tall and 52" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders with one amputated foot or two amputated feet (amputation below the knee), with or without prosthesis, may ride provided the rider has the ability to hold on with two functioning hands. Riders with one missing arm or hand may ride, provided the rider has the ability to hold on with one functioning hand and brace themselves with one functioning leg. Riders must step up and down into an elevated ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.

Up, Up & Away (Kidzopolis)

A gentle circular ride with some elevation.

Height Restriction: Riders under 42" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing and must include a hand) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit. Viper

An exciting roller coaster with high speed turns and steep drops and sudden stops.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 48" tall to ride.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm which can be used for gripping and bracing) and one complete leg extremity (natural leg used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit) to ride. Riders can also possess two functioning arm extremities and two functioning leg extremities that include a knee. For your safety and the safety of others, riders must remove medical devices including crutches, canes, prosthesis and any other type of medical assistance device that is not permanently affixed to the rider's body to prevent hazards or loss due to ride forces. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV (or a member of their party) should proceed up the exit ramp and present a valid Attraction Accessibility Pass to a Team Member at the exit to receive a wait time.

Wrath of Rakshasa

An exciting roller coaster with high speeds, steep drops, fast turns, inverted loops, and sudden stops.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 48" tall and under 78" tall to ride.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders with one amputated leg or two amputated legs (amputation above the knee), with or without prosthesis, shall not be allowed on the ride. Riders with one amputated leg or two amputated legs (amputation below the knee) may ride provided such rider has the ability to hold on with two functioning hands. A rider with one missing arm or hand may ride, provided such rider has the ability to hold on with one functioning hand and to brace self with two functioning legs. For your safety and the safety of others, riders must remove medical devices including crutches, canes, leg prosthesis and any other type of medical assistance device that is not permanently affixed to the rider's body to prevent hazards or loss due to ride forces. Arm prosthesis are permitted as long as they are properly secured under the dynamic forces of the ride. Arm/leg casts are not permitted on the ride. Riders using a wheelchair must transfer from the wheelchair onto the ride. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV (or a member of their party) should proceed up the exit ramp and present a valid Attraction Accessibility Pass to a Team Member at the exit.

Whizzer

A high speed roller coaster with sudden turns and drops.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 36" tall to ride. Riders between 36" tall and 42" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one complete arm extremity (natural arm or a prosthesis which can be used for gripping and bracing) and two complete leg extremities (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit) to ride. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV (or a member of their party) should proceed up the exit and present a valid Attraction Accessibility Pass to a Team Member at the exit to receive a wait time. This ride was constructed before the Americans with Disabilities Act and is only accessible via stairs.

Winner's Circle Go Karts

A driving attraction with sharp turns, sudden stops, and possible bumps.

Height Restriction: Riders must be at least 58" tall to drive. Passengers must be at least 40" to ride. Drivers carrying a passenger must be 18 years old or the parent or legal guardian of the passenger. This does not apply if the passenger is an eligible driver.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Drivers must exhibit sufficient visual acuity to operate the car safely. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest during the duration of the ride and their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Drivers must possess one complete arm extremities (natural arm or a prosthesis which can be used for gripping and bracing) and two complete leg extremities (natural leg or a prosthesis used for bracing the body during the course of participation and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit) to ride. Drivers must have the ability to hold and turn the steering wheel and press the foot pedal. Passengers must have at least three complete extremities to ride. Passengers must have the ability to brace themselves. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle.

Casts may not restrict the rider from bending the elbow or knee, and may not restrict the restraints in any way.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter next to the exit.

X Flight

Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, with their head against the headrest for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders with one amputated leg or two amputated legs (amputation above the knee), with or without prosthesis, shall not be allowed on the ride. Riders with one amputated leg or two amputated legs (amputation below the knee) may ride provided such rider has the ability to hold on with two functioning hands. Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Riders must possess upper body control, the ability to sit in an upright position and maintain an upright posture. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.

ZoomJets (Kidzopolis)

A slow moving circular ride with mild up and down motion.

Height Restriction: Riders under 48" tall must ride with a rider over 54" tall. Riders are not permitted to sit on the lap of another rider.

Physical Requirements: Do not ride if you have any of the following conditions: recent surgery or illness, heart conditions, neck, back, or bone ailments, pregnancy, high blood pressure or aneurysms, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Each rider must maintain an upright seated position, unsupported, for the duration of the ride, with their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders with one amputated foot or two amputated feet (amputation below the knee), with or without prosthesis, may ride provided the rider has the ability to hold on with one functioning hand. Riders with one missing arm or hand may ride, provided the rider has the ability to hold on with one functioning hand and brace themselves with one functioning leg. Riders must step up and down into an elevated ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Due to the restraints, some larger bodied riders may not be able to ride.

Ride Access: Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the ride exit.
