

Renovation plan for Pena Palace

Below is a list of renovations planned for Pena. Read carefully to understand which areas will be occupied due to restoration. While this is great for a close look at how conservation happens, it's crucial to note that ongoing works can make certain sections completely or partially inaccessible. If there's something you're especially eager to see, check this plan and schedule your visit accordingly.

Additionally, bad weather can impact your experience as certain sections lack shelter, so be sure to bring an umbrella or rain gear for a more comfortable visit.

Until February 2025: Restoration of wall coverings in the Royal Kitchen corridor and Tower staircase.

Until April 2025: Maintenance of historic luminaires.

Until June 2025: Restoration of the Southeast and Northeast façades at the palace entrance.

Until December 2025: Ongoing restoration of window openings throughout the palace.

Until February 2026: Maintenance of the non-slip sidewalk near the Moorish Castle Visitor Support Centre on Calçada da Pena.

Open for Works

Since 2006, the Aberto para Obras (Open for Works) initiative has allowed visitors to observe ongoing restoration and conservation efforts up close. This initiative fosters dialogue with specialist technicians while preserving Sintra's historic monuments.
