Package Name	USP (Unique Selling Point)	Recommended Duration + Itinerary	Recommended For
<b>Theme Park 1-Day Pass</b>	Provides a full day of LEGO-themed adventure with 40+ rides and shows across 8 themed lands.	Full day (open ~10AM to close ~6PM). Arrive early to cover all major zones, take breaks for lunch and live shows, and visit Miniland before finishing.	Families with children (around 4–12), LEGO fans, and first-time visitors who want the classic theme park experience.
<b>Water Park 1-Day Pass</b>	Offers a splash-filled day with 20+ LEGO-themed water slides and attractions – perfect for cooling off and playing.	Half-day (~4 hr–6 hr) or more. Arrive at opening to beat crowds on big slides, then relax in the LEGO wave pool and float along the Build-A-Raft lazy river in the afternoon.	Families who love water play, especially on hot days. Ideal for kids of all ages who enjoy slides, pools, and splash zones.
<b>SEA LIFE 1-Day Pass</b>	Interactive aquarium with 120+ marine species across 11 themed zones – a fun, educational underwater adventure.	About 1 hr–1.5 hr to explore. Stroll through all exhibits at a leisurely pace, enjoy the ocean tunnel, and check out the interactive touch pools.	Families with toddlers or anyone wanting a shorter, indoor activity. Great for a calm outing or as an educational add-on to other park visits.

<b>Theme Park + Water Park 1-Day Pass</b>	Thrilling rides and water slides in one day – get the best of both theme park excitement and water park fun.	Full day (open to close). Spend the morning at the Theme Park for key rides, then after lunch switch to the Water Park to cool off and enjoy slides until closing.	Active families and day-trippers with enough energy for two parks in one day. Best for older kids who can handle a full day of walking and swimming.
<b>Theme Park + SEA LIFE 1-Day Pass</b>	Thrills plus underwater wonders – combine roller coaster excitement with an aquarium adventure in one ticket.	Full day. Enjoy the Theme Park for ~5 hr–6 hr, then spend about an hour at SEA LIFE (either mid-day for an air-conditioned break or at the end of the day to wind down).	Families seeking a mix of high-energy and educational fun. Perfect if you want the main park experience but also a shorter, indoor attraction for variety (good for younger kids).
<b>Water Park + SEA LIFE 1-Day Pass</b>	Water play and marine discovery – a relaxed combo that mixes splashy fun with an educational aquarium visit.	One leisurely day. Play at the Water Park for a few hours (morning till mid-afternoon), then dry off and head to SEA LIFE for a 1 hr–2 hr indoor exploration before evening.	Families with younger children or anyone preferring gentler attractions. Great for a laid-back day without the fast-paced rides of the theme park.

<b>Theme Park + SEA LIFE + Water Park 1-Day Pass</b>	All three parks in one day – the ultimate LEGOLAND adventure for those eager to experience everything in a short time.	Full day (very packed). Start at opening with must-do rides in the Theme Park, cool off at the Water Park by mid-day, then visit SEA LIFE for about an hour in late afternoon. Prioritize highlights, as time will be tight.	Enthusiastic visitors on a tight schedule. Best for families with older kids or adults who can handle a fast-paced day. Not recommended for very young children due to the hectic itinerary.
<b>Theme Park + SEA LIFE + Water Park 2-Day Pass</b>	All parks over two days – the complete LEGOLAND experience, allowing you to enjoy everything without rushing.	Two full days. For example: dedicate Day 1 to the Theme Park (plus SEA LIFE in the afternoon or after rides), and Day 2 to the Water Park (with time to revisit favorite attractions). This way you cover all parks at a comfortable pace.	Families on vacation or serious LEGO fans who want to see it all. Ideal for a weekend trip, letting you experience every park in depth and even repeat favorites.
